Purpose

Educator of the Year is awarded by the NCSRC to recognize an individual who has made significant contributions to and exemplified outstanding service and leadership in respiratory therapy education.

Nomination Criteria

To be nominated as *Educator of the Year*, the nominee must

- Be an active member of the AARC/NCSRC.
- Hold an active license from the NCRCB.
- Be actively involved in the educational preparation of Respiratory Therapy Students.
- Spend a minimum of 50% of his/her time directly teaching and precepting Respiratory Therapy Students.

Nomination Process

Nominations should be submitted to any member of the NCSRC and include
